A RESOLUTION SUPPORTING THE MODERNIZATION OF THE NATIVE AMERICAN HOUSING ASSISTANCE AND SELF-DETERMINATION ACT

WHEREAS, the National American Indian Housing Council represents the housing interests of American Indian tribes, Alaska Native villages, and Department of Hawaiian Home Lands and Tribally designated housing entities providing housing services to approximately 431 Tribes, Alaska Natives, and Native Hawaiians; and


WHEREAS, the stated purpose of the organization is to promote advocacy for policy and legislative changes that will favorably impact on our primary goals of providing culturally relevant and quality affordable housing for Native people in a manner recognizing the unique government-to-government relationship of tribes and the federal government; and

WHEREAS, the United States Congress recognized the need for housing assistance and economic development in Indian Country when it passed the Native American Housing Assistance and Self-Determination Act of 1996 (NAHASDA) as amended.

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that the National American Indian Housing Council does hereby support the reauthorization of the Native American Housing Assistance and Self-Determination Act of 1996.
