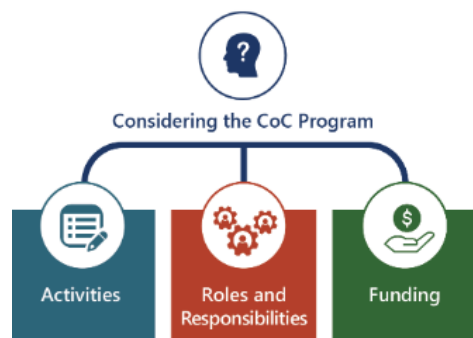
Explore the Continuum of Care (CoC) Program and the Tribal Homelessness Network (THN)

The THN is a HUD-supported forum for Tribes and TDHEs to collaborate and learn about the CoC program to address homelessness. The THN provides a platform for peer-to-peer learning, group discussions, and technical assistance (TA).

Through the THN, Tribes and TDHEs can:

- Build their understanding of the CoC Program, including eligibility requirements, project types, funding opportunities, and partnership options.
- Learn from peers and Tribal communities across the country by sharing experiences, successful approaches, and lessons learned in addressing homelessness.
- Explore opportunities to participate in or develop a CoC, and identify ways to align CoC resources with Tribal housing and homelessness priorities.
- Access individualized TA to address questions, navigate challenges, and support community planning efforts.
